SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 59, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING THE CORNERS, BOUNDARIES, AND SUBDIVISIONS OF SECTION 9-17-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK AT THE REQUEST OF CHARLES WILKINSON RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 138 DATED NOVEMBER 12, 1902, SAID THAT **HE SET A 24" X 12" X 3" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/8TH CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
