- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 59, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING THE CORNERS, BOUNDARIES, AND SUBDIVISIONS OF SECTION 9-17-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK AT THE REQUEST OF CHARLES WILKINSON RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 138 DATED NOVEMBER 12, 1902, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. SEE ALSO PACKED "M 133" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON THIS LEGAL SURVEY. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 98 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS.

- 2) 20.08 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 20" X 12" X 2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10
