

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 59, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING THE CORNERS, BOUNDARIES, AND SUBDIVISIONS OF SECTION 9-17-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK AT THE REQUEST OF CHARLES WILKINSON RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 138 DATED NOVEMBER 12, 1902, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY FLAG** FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. SEE ALSO PACKET "M 133" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 98 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING NOTES/SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.14-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10
- 2) 20.14-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 16" X 12" X 2-1/2" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10
- 3) 60.43-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-17-10
