

CENTER CORNER SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 11, 2012 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 12080-02, A SURVEY OF THE EAST AND WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 11-17-10 FOR DON KILTAU, SURVEY F11002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 30" IRON PIN WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS.

- 1) 2' NORTH TO A FENCE TO THE EAST
- 2) 3' WEST TO A HEDGE TO THE SOUTH
- 3) 1.9' NW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE EAST FACE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
- 4) 9.2' ENE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE WEST FACE OF A BRACE POST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,321.93' WEST TO THE 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 11-17-10
- 2) 2,643.86' WEST TO THE 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 11-17-10
- 3) 2,638.53' NORTH TO THE 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 11-17-10
- 4) 2,643.78' EAST TO THE SET CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IN A DRILL HOLE HE MADE FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 11-17-10
- 5) 2,647.40' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 11-17-10
