BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 9, 2006, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 06201-02 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FOR DOLD/BOYCE, SURVEY F13001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS.**
 - 1) 2.05' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 2.4' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH
 - 3) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE EAST AND WEST

 - 1) 1,316.97' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
 - 2) 2,633.94' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
 - 3) 2,646.85' NORTH TO THE 3/4" SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FROM AI CHAMNESS
 - 4) 2,636.87' EAST TO THE 3/4" SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FROM AI CHAMNESS
 - 5) 2,641.96' SOUTH TO THE 3/4" SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FROM AI CHAMNESS
