

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 9, 2006, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 06201-02 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FOR DOLD/BOYCE, SURVEY F13001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-10.

- 1) 1.0' EAST TO A FENCE TO THE NORTH
- 2) 2.3' NNE TO A CONCRETE NAIL IN A CORNER FENCE POST
- 3) 2.0' NORTH TO A FENCE TO THE WEST AND EAST

- 1) 1,316.97' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
- 2) 1,316.97' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
- 3) 3,953.84' EAST TO THE 3/4" SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE FROM AI CHAMNESS
- 4) 1,323.24' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A TRACT CORNER
- 5) 2,643.18' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
