BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F13001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, DATED JUNE 9, 2006 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 06201-02 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 FOR DOLD/BOYCE, SURVEY F13001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SHOWS ON HIS DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10 TO BE ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-10, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,323.84' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
- 2) 1,323.84' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP IN A MONUMENT WELL HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-10
- 3) 40.00' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A WITNESS CORNER
- 4) 1,316.17' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR A TRACT CORNER
