

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 113 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 35 DATED JUNE 20, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 24" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,328-1/4' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-10
- 2) 1,328-1/4' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-10
