

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH,
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 99 DATED JUNE 17-30, 1886 AND RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS VOLUME 36 ON PAGES 495 & 496 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1886, TO ESTABLISH THE MISSING CORNERS AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 7-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET AN 18" X 9" X 6" STONE MARKED "1/8" ON THE NORTH SIDE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AND HE RESET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 2) 20.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AND **HE RESET** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10
- 3) 59.12 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE
