RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 177 DATED MAY 4, 1920 ORDERED BY JOHN RYMAN TO SURVEY HIS LAND IN THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 19-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE IN PLACE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,329.20' SOUTH TO THE "PERMANENT POINT" HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10 – NOT IDENTIFIED
- 2) 2,658.35' SOUTH TO THE "PERMANENT POINT" HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10 – NOT IDENTIFIED
- 3) 3,987.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE IN PLACE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10
