

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, BY C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 126 DATED APRIL 12, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF P. BOSTIAN TO SURVEY AND ESTABLISH IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 10, THE 1/4 CORNER AND THE 1/8TH CORNER ON THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 19 AND THE 1/8TH CORNER BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE, AND SUCH OTHER LINES AND CORNERS AS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.10-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10
- 2) 20.10-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10
