

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, BY C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 126 DATED APRIL 12, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF P. BOSTIAN TO SURVEY AND ESTABLISH IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 10, THE 1/4 CORNER AND THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 19 AND THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE, AND SUCH OTHER LINES AND CORNERS AS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE, AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.05 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10
  - 2) 20.05 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10
  - 3) 40.10 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10
  - 4) 60.15 CHAINS ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10
- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "A", PAGE 45  
ON MARCH 1, 1915 A PETITION SIGNED BY JOHN P. BAIN AND OTHERS FOR THE LOCATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 17-10 WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED ON APRIL 13, 1915, AND THE FINAL ORDER WAS ISSUED ON MAY, 1915.
    - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10; THENCE EAST ON SAID LAND TO A POINT OPPOSITE THE BEND IN A RAVINE A LITTLE BEYOND THE HOUSE ON THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10; THENCE SOUTH TO SAID RAVINE; THENCE FOLLOWING OVER SAID RAVINE IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SAID RAVINE TO A CULVERT ACROSS SAID RAVINE; THENCE ACROSS SAID RAVINE TO WRIGHTS CREEK; THENCE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION UP SAID CREEK TO THE NORTH SIDE OF A WOODEN BRIDGE ACROSS SAID CREEK.
    - 2) ROAD TO BE LOCATED ON ABOVE DESCRIBED PREMISES BELONGING TO MARSHALL HURST
    - 3) ROAD WAS GRANTED AT 25 FEET IN WIDTH
  - 3) W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 693 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "E" ON PAGE 50 PETITIONED BY JOHN P. BAIN AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 17-10 [PACKET 786 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE], THAT WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY SURVEYOR ON APRIL 13, 1915 AND WAS GRANTED AS A 20 FOOT WIDE ROAD, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT **10 FEET SOUTH** OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19-17-10.  
THE VIEWERS DESCRIBED THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD AS FOLLOWS:
    - 1) BEGINNING AT A POINT 10 FEET SOUTH OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-10; THENCE EASTERLY 1,118 FEET

MAKING A SOUTHEAST ANGLE WITH THE SECTION LINE OF  $89^{\circ}35'$ ; THENCE WITH AN ANGLE TO THE RIGHT  $91^{\circ}06'$  FOR 190 FEET; THENCE DEFLECTING TO THE LEFT  $24^{\circ}22'$  FOR A DISTANCE OF 135 FEET; THENCE TO THE LEFT AN ANGLE  $15^{\circ}46'$  FOR A DISTANCE OF 155 FEET; THENCE TO THE LEFT ANGLE  $28^{\circ}32'$  A DISTANCE OF 107 FEET; THENCE LEFT  $33^{\circ}40'$  A DISTANCE OF 69 FEET; THENCE LEFT  $14^{\circ}00'$  A DISTANCE OF 120 FEET; THENCE RIGHT  $46^{\circ}35'$  A DISTANCE OF 159 FEET; THENCE RIGHT  $4^{\circ}00'$  FOR 145 FEET; THENCE LEFT  $40^{\circ}05'$  FOR 102 FEET; THENCE RIGHT  $49^{\circ}30'$  FOR 130 FEET; THENCE LEFT  $49^{\circ}32'$  FOR 112 FEET; THENCE LEFT  $27^{\circ}00'$  FOR 75 FEET; THENCE  $28^{\circ}30'$  FOR 75 FEET TO A POINT AT THE WEST SIDE OF THE BRIDGE OVER WRIGHT CREEK AS PER THE PLAT ATTACHED HERETO
