

INDIAN RESERVE CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 163 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THE SET AN 18" X 14" X 3" LIMESTONE** ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN DIMINISHED RESERVE ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 20.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 10.15 CHAINS WEST TO THE 16" X 14" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 17 & 20
 - 2) 50.20 CHAINS WEST TO THE 20" X 16" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19, 20, 29 & 30
 - 3) 29.90 CHAINS EAST TO THE 30" X 12" X 5" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21

- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 141, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 222 DATED JANUARY 23-30, 1906 AT THE ORDER OF JOHN GUTHRIE FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THAT PORTION OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-10 WHICH LIES EAST OF THE EAST LINE OF THE DIMINISHED KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION, EXCEPTING THOSE ON THE NORTH LINE, AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE DROVE A BOLT WITH A SQUARE HEAD** ON THE INDIAN LINE ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED: "PROPORTIONAL MEASUREMENTS CAN NOT BE USED IN SURVEYS ON INDIAN LINE – SEE SURVEY SECTION 20 IN REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE".
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 10.07 CHAINS WEST TO THE 18" IRON ROD HE DROVE FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-10, AT 44 LINKS NORTH OF A STONE WALL AND 13 LINKS WEST OF A FENCE TO THE SOUTH
 - 2) 50.11 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-10
 - 3) 30.39 CHAINS EAST TO THE PIECE OF SICKLE BAR HE DROVE IN A ROCK LEDGE FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 17-17-10
 - 4) 70.45 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16-17-10, AT 39 LINKS SOUTH OF THE END OF A HEDGE
 - 5) 19.99 CHAINS NORTH ON THE INDIAN LINE TO THE 22" X 8" X 7" STONE HE SET ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY
 - 6) 39.98 CHAINS NORTH TO A PIECE OF 1-1/2" GAS PIPE HE SET ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 17 -17-10, LOCATED 8 LINKS NORTH OF A FENCE
