

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, BY C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 125 DATED APRIL 11, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF J. E. ROBERTS TO SURVEY AND ESTABLISH IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 10, THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20 AND THE 18TH CORNER BETWEEN THE CENTER AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WEST, THE 1/8TH CORNER BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SECTION AND THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH, AND THE 1/16TH CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND SUCH OTHER LINES AND CORNERS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-17-10 ON THIS **LEGAL SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 20.11-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/16TH CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-17-10
- 2) 40.23 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-17-10
