

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN VOLUME 3 ON PAGE 555 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON MAY 29, 1880 AND SURVEY F21001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS SURVEY ON APRIL 22, 1880. **HE FOUND THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10 AT 3 LINKS WEST OF THE LINE BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY.**  
**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
  - 1) 19.88-1/2 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
  - 2) 19.88 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
  - 3) 59.64-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
