

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN VOLUME 3 ON PAGE 555 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON MAY 29, 1880 AND SURVEY F21001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 , AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS SURVEY ON APRIL 22, 1880. **HE SET A ROCK 20-1/2" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.96 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
- 2) 19.96 CHAINS NORTH TO THE LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
- 3) 39.93-1/8 CHAINS NORTH TO THE LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10
- 4) 59.90-1/4 CHAINS NORTH TO THE LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
