- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 112 OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 34 DATED JUNE 19, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22 AND FIND THE CENTER OF SECTION 22-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 20" X 6" X 5" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
