

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 153 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 14" X 2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 21 & 22-17-10.

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 112 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 34 DATED JUNE 19, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 & 22 AND FIND THE CENTER OF SECTION 22-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,673' EAST TO THE 20" X 6" X 5" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-10

- 3) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN VOLUME 3 ON PAGE 555 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON MAY 29, 1880 AND SURVEY F21001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTHEAST 1/4, AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 , AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , AND THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 , AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS SURVEY ON APRIL 22, 1880. **HE SET A LIMESTONE 17" X 7" X 5"** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 20.03-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 21-17-10
 - 2) 40.07 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10
 - 3) 40.07 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 21-17-10

- 4) **REA PIN—MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING; THIS CORNER WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED—IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY! SEE R.E.A. BOOKS 30 & 31. WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 20' WEST TO A WITNESS

- 5) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NW14 SECTION 22-17-10". **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD BEFORE USING; THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED—IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY! SEE R.E.A. BOOKS 30 & 31. WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
