BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F23003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 DATED MARCH 26, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10065-02, FOR A SURVEY FOR KERMIT GROTHER TO SURVEY THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/16TH CORNERS. HE SAID TO SEE A PRIOR SURVEY BY J. H. HIBBEN DATED 1880 IN BOOK 3 AT PAGE 561 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.

- 1) 1,334.95' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
- 2) 1,326.36' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-16-10
- 3) 1,334.95' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
- 4) 1,326.36' SOUTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
