

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F23003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 DATED MARCH 26, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10065-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10 FOR KERMIT GROTHER, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE EAST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10 TO BE ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY. HE SAID TO SEE A PRIOR SURVEY BY J. H. HIBBEN DATED 1880 IN BOOK 3 AT PAGE 561 AT THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE.

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,327.15' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
- 2) 1,327.15' SOUTH TO THE CONCRETE NAIL OVER THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
- 3) 1,334.95' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
- 4) 2,669.90' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-10
