HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN VOLUME 3 ON PAGE 561 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE FOR A SURVEY DATED APRIL 12-14, 1880 AND SURVEY F23001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS TO THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26, THE SOUTH CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 24, ALSO THE NORTH & WEST & SOUTH CORNERS OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTH CORNERS OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTH AND SOUTH CORNERS OF THE NORTH 1/2, AND THE NORTH & WEST CORNERS OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 25, ALSO THE EAST & SOUTH CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 24, AND ALSO THE EAST CORNERS TO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 17" X 4" X 2" ROCK** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 25-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**
