

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 86 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 181 DATED FEBRUARY 8, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY A. G. EDMISTON, BEING THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-17-10 ON THIS SURVEY.
  
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A SURVEY DATED MARCH 11, 1985 FOR A SURVEY OF A 18.92 ACRE TRACT IN THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-17-10, RECORDED IN VOLUME 413 ON PAGE 885 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON MARCH 18, 1885, AND SURVEY F28001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 4" X 4" LIMESTONE ATTRIBUTED TO COUNTY SURVEYOR D. T. McAULEY** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-17-10. **HE SET A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STONE.**
  - 1) ON THE NORTH SIDE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
  - 2) IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

  - 1) 1,318.25' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 28-178-10
  - 2) 2,636.50' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-17-10
  
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 14, 1991, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE ATTRIBUTED TO COUNTY SURVEYOR D. T. McAULEY** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-17-10 FROM HIS EXISTING REFERENCES DATED MARCH 1985. **HE SET A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STONE.**

  - 2) IN LINE WITH FENCES TO THE NORTH & SOUTH
