

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 28 TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 48 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 105 DATED OCTOBER 28, 1874 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 29-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,343-1/2' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 2) 1,343-1/2' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 3) 2,000' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KAW DIMINISHED RESERVE
- 4) 2,659' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
