

**INDIAN RESERVE CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

DOTY TO SURVEY SECTION 29-17-10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 81 DATED DECEMBER 22-27, 1884 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 29 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887, SURVEY F29001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 6" X 10" X 14" STONE** ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 671.5' EAST TO THE 4" X 15" X 18" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 2) 2,004' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 3) 661' WEST TO THE 4" X 5" X 30" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 4) 1,896.5' WEST TO THE 2" X 5" X 16" REFERENCE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 AS THE TRUE POSITION FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER
- 5) 1,985' WEST TO THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 – FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER
- 6) 3,309' WEST TO THE 5" X 5" X 14" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 7) 1,332' SOUTH ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE TO THE 6" X 12" X 14" STONE HE SET
- 8) 2,664' SOUTH ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
