

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 29 TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 47 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 104 AND DATED OCTOBER 16, 1874 FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 19-17-10, SAID THAT AFTER HE RAN THE SECTION LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 SOUTH TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTIONS 31-19-10, **HE RESET THE STONE** HE FOUND "AT THE CORRESPONDING CORRECTION OF 1/4 AND 1/8 CORNERS ON BOTH LINES AND SET UP THE OLD OR MARKED STONES I FOUND LYING NEAR THEIR RESPECTIVE PLACES" FOR THE EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 81, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** ORDERED BY J. J. DOTY TO SURVEY SECTION 29-17-10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 81 DATED DECEMBER 22-27, 1884 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 29 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887, SURVEY F29001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER. HE DETERMINED THE TRUE POSITION TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FROM THE TRUE POSITION:
 - 1) 100' NORTH TO THE 4" X 6" X 14" REFERENCE STONE HE SET ON THE SECTION LINE
 - 2) 1,317.5' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
 - 3) 70' SOUTH TO THE 5" X 5" X 14" REFERENCE STONE HE SET ON THE SECTION LINE
 - 4) 1,317.5' SOUTH TO THE 5" X 5" X 14" STONE HE SET FOR PERMANENT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
 - 5) 2,635' SOUTH TO THE 5" X 9" X 16" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
 - 6) 3,952.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
