

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 48 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 105 DATED OCTOBER 28, 1874 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 29-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 659' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KAW DIMINISHED RESERVE
- 2) 2,659' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
