

**SOUTHEAST CORNER NORTH 1/2 LOT 2 NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 30,  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** WITH THE MORRIS COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 182 DATED MARCH 27, 1900 AT THE ORDER OF W. H. ROBINSON TO SURVEY GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5" X 6" X 15" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 2 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LOT 2.

- 1) 19.94 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 4" X 8" X 16" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2
- 2) 19.94 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2
- 3) 18.28 CHAINS WEST TO THE 2-1/2" X 4" X 20" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE, OR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE N1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2
