

**WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE, SURVEY F30001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 DATED APRIL 26-30, 1880 TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, THE NORTH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4, THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4, THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, AND THE NORTH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 IN SECTION 31-17-10, AND ALSO THE SOUTH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10, SAID THAT **HE PLANTED A GOVERNMENT 1/16<sup>TH</sup> ROCK** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10 AND THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 20.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STAKE HE PLANTED FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10
  - 2) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STAKE HE PLANTED FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10
  - 3) 60.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10 THAT HE ESTABLISHED FROM WITNESS TREES
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, BY C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 126 AND DATED APRIL 1882, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE AT THE "PROPER CORRECTION" ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** WITH THE MORRIS COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 182 DATED MARCH 27, 1900 AT THE ORDER OF W. H. ROBINSON TO SURVEY GOVERNMENT LOT 2 IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A 2-1/2" X 4" X 20" STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON AND MORRIS COUNTY LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10
- 2) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-17-10
- 3) 18.28 CHAINS EAST TO THE 5" X 6" X 15" STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE N1/2 OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2
