

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 32 TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH,  
RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 48 OF THE 8<sup>TH</sup> TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 105 DATED OCTOBER 28, 1874 TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 29-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,315' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
  - 2) 1,315' EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
  - 3) 3,945' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 81, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** ORDERED BY J. J. DOTY TO SURVEY SECTION 29-17-10 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 81 DATED DECEMBER 22-27, 1884 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 41 ON PAGE 29 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JANUARY 27, 1887, SURVEY F29001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,333' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
  - 2) 1,333' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-10
  - 3) 1,988' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29-17-10
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 159, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 159 DATED FEBRUARY 9-12, 1887 ORDERED BY J. J. DOTY AND SAMUEL HASSINGER TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS FOR ALL PARTIES OWNING LAND IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-17-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE SAID THAT AFTER CHECKING BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10 AND THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10, HE DETERMINED THAT THIS STONE WAS **12 FEET NORTH OF THE TRUE LINE**. HE SAID THAT SINCE THE CORNER WAS RECOGNIZED AS THE CORNER BY THE INTERESTED PARTIES, HE DID **NOT** CHANGE THE LOCATION OF THIS CORNER. HE NOTED THAT "THE BEARING OF A TRUE LINE FROM THE N 1/4 TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER IS 82°07', BUT AS THE LINE HAS BEEN LOCATED THE EAST 1/2 OF IT HAS A VAR. OF 82°48' AND THE WEST 1/2 IS 81°44.'" HE COMMENTED THAT THE EAST HALF IS 1,327 FEET IN LENGTH AND THE WEST HALF WAS 1,325 FEET IN LENGTH.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 662-1/2' WEST TO THE LOCATION FOR THE PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER, AS WITNESSED BY THE 4" X 8" X 20" LIMESTONE HE SET AT 87-1/2' WEST AND THE 5" X 9" X 17" LIMESTONE HE SET AT 4' SOUTH

- 2) 1,325' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10
- 3) 663-1/2" EAST TO THE LIMESTONE 4" X 6" AT THE TOP, 7" X 12" AT THE BASE AND 20" LONG HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
- 4) 1,327' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10
- 5) 330-1/4' SOUTH TO THE LOCATION FOR THE PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER, AS WITNESSED BY THE 6" X 6" X 17" LIMESTONE HE SET AT 50' WEST, THE 3" X 10" X 12" LIMESTONE HE SET AT 100' EAST, AND THE 3" X 6" X 12" LIMESTONE HE SET AT 130' NORTH
- 6) 660-1/2' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 6" X 16" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
- 7) 990-3/4' SOUTH TO THE 3" X 7" X 13" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
- 8) 1,321' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 8" X 18" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NW/14 OF SECTION 32-17-10
