- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 159, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 159 DATED FEBRUARY 9-12, 1887 ORDERED BY J. J. DOTY AND SAMUEL HASSINGER TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS FOR ALL PARTIES OWNING LAND IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-17-10, SAID THAT HE SET A **STAKE** FOR THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-17-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 32-17-10 THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 991' NORTH TO THE 7" X 4" X 20" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR A PERMANENT PROPERTY CORNER
 - 2) 1,321' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10
 - 3) 1,321' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-17-10
