- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 81 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 175 & 178 DATED JANUARY 26 & 27, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY G. ANDERSON AND J. McCAIN SITUATED IN SECTION 34-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 81 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
 - 2) 81 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 2) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 135 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 218 DATED OCTOBER 21, 1869 TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHEAST CORNERS OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE ALREADY ESTABLISHED** ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THIS SURVEY.
