

WEST 1/16 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 81 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 175 & 178 DATED JANUARY 26 & 27, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY G. ANDERSON AND J. McCAIN SITUATED IN SECTION 34-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 80 RODS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 3) 160 RODS, 41 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 4) 80 RODS, 7-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 5) 160 RODS, 15 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 6) 80 RODS, 22-3/4 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 7) 160 RODS, 45-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10
