- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 81 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 175 & 178 DATED JANUARY 26 & 27, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY G. ANDERSON AND J. McCAIN SITUATED IN SECTION 34-17-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-17-10 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 80 RODS, 9-3/4 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 80 RODS, 9-3/4 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
- 3) 240 RODS, 29-1/4 RODS NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-17-10
