

CENTER CORNER SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 130 DATED MAY 2 & 3, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF H. T. SWARNER TO SURVEY AND ESTABLISH IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 11, THE CENTER OF SECTION 5, THE CORNER ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE, AND THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 5, AND THE 1/2 MILE CORNER ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE IN SECTION 5, AND SUCH OTHER LINES AND CORNERS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 TO THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2 MILE CORNER ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE IN SECTION 5-17-11, WITH THE LINE FROM THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 12, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10112-02, SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 FOR A SURVEY OF THE WEST HALF OF THE FRACTIONAL NORTHWEST 1/4 AND THE EAST HALF OF THE FRACTIONAL NORTHWEST 1/4; [AKA GOVERNMENT LOT 7 AND THE WEST HALF OF GOVERNMENT LOT 8 AND GOVERNMENT LOT 6 AND THE EAST HALF OF GOVERNMENT LOT 8] ALL IN SECTION 5-17-11 FOR EK REALTY, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 BY RETRACING THE PERMANENT SURVEY BY COUNTY SURVEYOR RICE IN 1882 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH QUARTER CORNERS OF SECTION 5-17-11, AND THE LINE FROM THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-17-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 9 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION.
 - 1) IN LINE WITH THE HEDGE TO THE NORTH EXTENDED
 - 2) IN LINE WITH THE HEDGE EAST-WEST
 - 3) 7.6' SSE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN THE EAST FACE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 4) 2.5' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & WASHER IN THE NORTH FACE OF A 36" HEDGE TREE
 - 5) 6.4' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE WEST
 - 6) 2.0' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH EXTENDED

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

 - 1) 1,119.91' EAST TO THE 4" X 12" X 17" LIMESTONE HE FOUND ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 9 [AKA NORTHEAST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 10]
 - 2) 1,320.24' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-17-11
 - 3) 2,640.48' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-17-11 [AKA SOUTHWEST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 8 AND NORTHWEST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 12]
 - 4) 2,464.36' NORTH TO THE #5 SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-17-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE [AKA NORTHEAST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 6]
 - 5) 2,647.48' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP AT THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-17-11 [AKA SOUTHEAST CORNER GOVERNMENT LOT 12]
