

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 12, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10112-02, SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 17" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE ON THE INDIAN RESERVE LINE FIRM IN THE GROUND AT THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-17-11 [AKA SOUTHEAST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 9] FROM THE SURVEY BY RICE IN 1882.**
 - 1) 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STONE
 - 2) 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET UNDER THE STONE
 - 3) 2.4' SOUTH TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A HEDGE TREE CORNER FENCE POST
 - 4) 13.5' WNW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A 14" HACKBERRY TREE
 - 5) 9.9' NORTH TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE EAST SIDE OF A 30" HEDGE TREE
 - 6) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE NORTH AND SOUTH
 - 7) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE WEST

- 1) 1,119.91' WEST TO THE 5/8" CAPPED REBAR HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11 [AKA SOUTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 9 AND NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 10]
- 2) 2,640.48' WEST TO THE 5/8" CAPPED REBAR HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11
- 3) 3,760.39' WEST TO THE 5/8" CAPPED REBAR HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE FRACTIONAL NW1/4 OF SECTION 5-16-11 [AKA NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 12 AND SOUTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 8]
