- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 7 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 62 DATED MARCH 5, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH, THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH, THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 BY A LINE EAST & WEST, THE NORTHEAST 1/4 BY A LINE NORTH & SOUTH, AND THE WEST 1/2 BY A LINE EAST & WEST, ALL IN SECTION 6-17-11, STATES THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 6-16-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,242' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
- 2) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6-17-11
