

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) THE KRETSINGER TIE BOOK FOR THIS TOWNSHIP SHOWS A **REA PIN SET** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11. **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR OTHER MONUMENTS BEFORE USING THIS PIN; THIS PIN WAS PROBABLY "HEELED-IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY! SEE "REA BOOKS 30 & 31". WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
  
- 2) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 10, 2001, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99476-02, SURVEY F08002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 FOR A SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11, SAID THAT **SHE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11 BY RUNNING THE LINE FROM THE NORTH 1/4 AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 8-17-11, AND INTERSECTING THIS LINE WITH A LINE FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11 TO THE CORNER POSITION ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVE LINE THAT IS HALF THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH SECTION LINE CORNERS ON THE RESERVE LINE.
  - 1) 26.55' SE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A CORNER POST
  - 2) 10.20' SSE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN THE EAST BRACE POST
  - 3) 7.25' NNE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A 6' DIAMETER ELM TREE
  - 4) 25.05' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH-EXTENDED
  - 5) 10.10' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE WEST-EXTENDED

  - 2) 2,648.39' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SHE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11
  - 3) 2,634.32' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 752" CAP SHE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11
  - 4) 1,211.57' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SHE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 6 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION

  - 1) 26.55' SE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A CORNER POST
  - 2) 10.20' SSE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN THE EAST BRACE POST
  - 3) 7.25' NNE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A 6' DIAMETER ELM TREE
  - 4) 25.05' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING TO THE NORTH [EXTENDED]
  - 5) 10.10' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE RUNNING TO THE WEST [EXTENDED]

  - 2) 2,648.39' NORTH TO THE 5/8" CAPPED REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF GOVERNMENT LOT 5 [AKA NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11]
