

NORTHEAST CORNER LOT 5—INDIAN RESERVE IN SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

1) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED APRIL 10, 2001, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 99476-02, SURVEY F08002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 FOR A SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11, SAID THAT SHE CONSIDERED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **LOST**. **SHE SET A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5 ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11 ON THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION AT THE PRORATED GLO FOR THE AREA FOR EAST-WEST POSITION, AND ON AN EXTENSION OF THE LINE FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11 OVER THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11.

- 1) 38.00' SE TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN AN 8" HEDGE TREE
- 2) 27.50' SSW TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A 12" HEDGE TREE
- 3) 30.20' NW TO A MASONRY NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A CORNER FENCE POST WITH CONCRETE BRACE PILLARS NORTH & SOUTH
- 4) 16.30' WEST TO AN OLD FENCE LINE TO THE NORTH – EXTENDED
- 5) 12.30' EAST TO A FENCE LINE TO THE SOUTH – EXTENDED
- 6) 4.3' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 300

- 3) 3,845.01' WEST TO THE STONE SHE FOUND WITH THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 752" CAPS ON THE NORTH & SOUTH SIDES OF THE STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-17-11
- 4) 2,646.48' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SHE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 6 ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION
- 5) 5,296.96' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SHE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 8 ON THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION

DAVIS, L.S. 1368, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 22, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03455-02, SURVEY F08003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 FOR A 7.20 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, BEING PART OF LOT 5 OF THE FRACTIONAL NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5 ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-17-11 ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE KANSAS INDIAN RESERVATION FROM EXISTING TIES OF RECORD IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE BY POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, DATED APRIL 2001.

- 1) 38.00' SE TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN AN 8" HEDGE TREE
- 2) 27.50' SSW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A 12" HEDGE TREE
- 3) 30.20' NW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A CORNER POST
- 4) 16.30' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH EXTENDED
- 5) 12.30' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH EXTENDED
- 6) 4.3' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE OF TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD 300

 - 1) 30.20' NW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 173.9' WNW TO A RAILROAD SPIKE IN A POWER POLE
 - 3) 26.4' NORTH TO A WASHER TIED TO THE TOP STRAND OF A WIRE FENCE
 - 4) 15.1' SOUTH TO A WASHER TIED TO THE TOP STRAND OF A WIRE FENCE
 - 5) 15.0' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH EXTENDED
 - 6) 13.0' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH EXTENDED
 - 7) 4.5' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF GRAVEL ROAD 300 EAST-WEST
