

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 321 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 & 9-17-11.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 39.91 CHAINS WEST TO THE 22" X 13" X 7" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4, 5, 8 & 9
 - 2) 39.91 CHAINS EAST TO THE 22" X 18" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 3, 4, 9 & 10

- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 145
ON MARCH 29, 1964 A PETITION SIGNED BY VIRGIL MARCOTT AND OTHERS FOR THE VACATION OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 17-11 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON APRIL 15, 1964 RECOMMENDING THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD BE VACATED:
 - 1) BEGINNING AT 1,980 FEET MORE OR LESS EAST OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-17-11, THENCE EAST TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 4-17-11 AND THERE ENDING.
