- 1) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 121 DATED APRIL 15, 1955 TO SET AN IRON PIN IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-11, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET AN IRON PIN** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON HIS SURVEY. THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,324.3' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-11
- 2) 2,648.6' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-11
- 3) 1,324.2' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY POINT HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 13-17-11
- 4) 2,648.4' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13-17-11 ON THE RANGE LINE
