- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 5, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10268-02, SURVEY F15004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11 FOR EMPORIA SATE BANK AND MOUNKES, SAID THAT **HE SET A COTTON GIN SPINDLE** FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11.
 - 1) 35' WEST TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET
 - 2) 39.5' WEST TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 3) 61.6' SW TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE WEST EXTENDED
 - 5) 1.0' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD "L" NORTH-SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

 - 1) 1,325.77' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 2) 445.00' SOUTH TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF TRACT "A", AS WITNESSED BY THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" HE SET AT THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE
 - 3) 1,325.77' SOUTH TO THE COTTON GIN SPINDLE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 4) 1,950.00' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF TRACT "A"
 - 5) 2,631.88' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
