

CENTER CORNER SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 46, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 227 DATED MARCH 18 & 21 AND CLOSED MAY 8, 1902 ORDERED BY ROBERT MOUNKES FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE NORTHEAST CORNER, THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST LINE, AND THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS ARE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET AN 18" X 6" X 6" STONE MARKED WITH A PLUS ("+") ON THE NORTH FACE FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE TRANSIT LINES BETWEEN THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 26, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 66" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 4 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.**

- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 5, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10268-02, SURVEY F15004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11 FOR EMPORIA SATE BANK AND MOUNKES, SAID THAT HE SEARCHED FOR THE STONE OF RECORD AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11 THAT WAS SET BY ALVA J. SMITH IN A 1902 PERMANENT SURVEY, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. **HE SET A 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11 BASED ON THE PHYSICAL EVIDENCE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER AND BY MEASUREMENT.
 - 1) ON THE EAST SIDE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
 - 2) 4.15' NORTH TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN THE EAST SIDE OF A BRACE POST
 - 3) 36.2' ENE TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A 22" DIAMETER TREE
 - 4) IN LINE WITH AN OLD FENCE TO THE WEST
 - 5) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

 - 1) 2,633.06' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 2) 1,324.46' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 3) 2,648.52' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
