BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED OCTOBER 5, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10268-02, SURVEY F15004 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11 FOR EMPORIA SATE BANK AND MOUNKES, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11 AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-11.
 - 1) 3' EAST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE NORTH AND SOUTH
 - 2) 1.5' SOUTH TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE EAST EXTENDED
 - 3) 3.4' ESE TO A 40 D NAIL IN THE WEST FACE OF A CORNER FENCE POST

 - 1) 1,324.26' NORTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 2) 1,324.26' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11
 - 3) 681.88' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF TRACT "A"
 - 4) 2,631.88' EAST TO THE COTTON GIN SPINDLE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-11, AND THE P.O.B. OF TRACT "A"
