- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 109 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 200 DATED APRIL 28, 1869 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY J. TILTS, TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17, AND ALSO THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 COF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-11 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-16-11 AT THE "PROPER CORRECTION" ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 78 RODS, 12 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-11
- 2) 156 RODS, 24 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 17-17-11
