TILTS, TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17, AND ALSO THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 17, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-11 ON LINE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-17-11 AT THE "PROPER CORRECTION" ON THIS SURVEY. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 80 RODS, 15 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-11
 - 2) 160 RODS, 30 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-17-11
