

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN HIS SURVEY DRAWING DATED NOVEMBER 4, 2013 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 13239-02, THE SURVEY OF A TRACT IN THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-11 FOR RON JACKSON, SURVEY F23002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-11 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-17-11, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,329.39' WEST TO THE 5/8" IRON PIN WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-11
- 2) 1,329.39' EAST TO THE 1/2" IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-11
- 3) 1,328.34' NORTH TO THE 1/2" X 24" IRON PIN WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 23-17-11, AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH EXCEPTED TRACT, WHICH FALLS 11.9 FEET SOUTH OF AN EAST-WEST FENCE AND 12 FEET EAST OF A NORTH-SOUTH FENCE
- 4) 1,748.04' NORTH TO A 1/2" X 24" IRON PIN WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTH EXCEPTED TRACT, WHICH FALLS ± 18 FEET SOUTH OF AN EAST-WEST FENCE AND ± 8 FEET EAST OF A NORTH-SOUTH FENCE
