

CENTER CORNER SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 86 & 87 [PACKET 146 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] DATED APRIL 1868, SAID THAT **HE FOUND** THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. **[NOTE:** BASED ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING IN THE ROAD RECORD BOOK AND THE PACKET, THIS ROAD DID **NOT** PASS THROUGH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-11. I BELIEVE THE CORRECT LOCATION SHOULD BE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-16-11 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]
- 2) **REA PIN—MUST VERIFY AND CHECK FOR OTHER MONUMENT BEFORE USING; THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED—IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR** REA BOOK 30 ON PAGE 15 SAYS THAT **THEY DROVE AN IRON PIN** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-11 AT 2,652.3' NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-17-11.
- 3) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 17-11 SHOWS A **REA PIN** AT THE "SW CORNER NE1/4 SECTION 29-17-11". **VERIFY AND CHECK FOR OTHER MONUMENT BEFORE USING; THIS IRON PIN WAS PROBABLY JUST "HEELED—IN" FOR UTILITY USE ONLY! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L. S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
