

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 53 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 13" X 3"** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-17-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY ON JANUARY 7, 1861.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 20" X 12" X " LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-17-11
- 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 18" X 10" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 17 & 18 SOUTH, RANGES 10 & 11 EAST AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-17-11

- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 1, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09227-02 AND SURVEY F36002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-10 FOR A SURVEY OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND A TRACT IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-17-10 FOR HANLINE, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY MAINTAINER FOR THE STONE AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE, BUT HE DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE. HE DETERMINED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **LOST** IN EAST-WEST POSITION AND **OBLITERATED** IN NORTH-SOUTH POSITION. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-10 ON THE RANGE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 36-17-10, AND IN LINE WITH THE FENCES TO THE EAST AND WEST.

- 1) 29.0' EAST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE WEST FACE OF A CORNER FENCE POST
- 2) 18.55' WEST TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLECAP IN THE EAST FACE OF A POWER POLE
- 3) 3.4' EAST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF COUNTY ROAD "G" NORTH-SOUTH
- 4) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE EAST
- 5) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE WEST
- 2) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE WEST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,644.21' SOUTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-11 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER
- 2) 2,652.99' NORTH ON THE RANGE LINE TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-11
- 3) 2,650.10' WEST TO THE 5/8" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-11
- 4) 5,290.83' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-17-11
