

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F15001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-12 FOR TRACTS IN THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-12 FOR HOWARD SCHLESSNER FOR PROJECT NUMBER 93662-02 DATED DECEMBER 16, 1993 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 483 ON PAGE 185 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON APRIL 18, 1994, NOTES IN HIS *REPORT OF SURVEY* THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-12 TO BE ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE SQUARE #6 IRON PIN THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-12 AND THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320.32' WEST TO THE SQUARE #6 IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-12
- 2) 1,320.32' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-12
- 3) 3,960.28' EAST TO THE 1/2" REBAR HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 15-17-12 FROM THE 1956 KRETSINGER PERMANENT SURVEY
- 4) 1,327.22' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-12
- 5) 2,015.19' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF TRACT "D"
- 6) 2,654.44' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" CAPPED REBAR HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 15-17-12
