

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A SURVEY RECORDED ON PAGE 887 OF VOLUME 419 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE AND SURVEY F22002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 17-12, FOR PROJECT 85134 DATED OCTOBER 03, 1985 FOR A SURVEY OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-17-12, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL LOCATION** FOR THE EAST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-12 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,327.17' SOUTH TO THE #4 REBAR HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-12
- 2) 1,327.17' NORTH TO THE #6 SQUARE REBAR HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22-17-12
- 3) 3,983.67' NORTH TO THE GLO STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22-15-12
- 4) 1,322.9' WEST TO THE #4 REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 22-15-12
- 5) 2,645.8' WEST TO THE #4 REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 22-17-12
